This year, the spread of the pandemic has confronted all teachers with the need to reshape and review their teaching strategies and methods like never before. Distance teaching, previously reserved for a few, has therefore urgently become the subject of reflections and attempts to respond to the challenges posed by the telematic medium. Is it possible to teach effectively from a distance? What are the best strategies to adopt? What are the peculiarities of language teaching in general and of the Chinese language in particular? What are the differences between courses at school, at university, in the Confucius Institutes? What are the obstacles and what are the assets of such teaching? This year's seminar aims to be a platform for sharing and exchange so as to discuss and address the issues of teaching the Chinese language with particular reference to the historical moment we are experiencing.
